



Mock Turtleneck Sweater

(Fits 18" doll such as American Girl™)

Materials:

4 ply worsted weight yarn
Crochet hook size I

Directions:

Sweater Front: Ch 29.

Row 1: Dc in 4th ch from hook, dc in each ch across. Ch 3, turn (counts as 1st dc on next and all following rows). (*Right side of work*)

Row 2: Dc in 12 sts, work next 3 sts as BP dcs, dc across. Ch 3, turn.

Row 3: Rep row 2, working FP dcs on 3 middle sts. Ch 3, turn.

Row 4: Rep row 2. Ch 1, turn.

Row 5: Sl st in 1st 6 sts, ch 3, dc in next 6 sts, work 3 FP dcs, dc in next 7 sts, ch 3, turn.

Row 6: Dc across, working BP dcs on middle 3 sts. Ch 3, turn.

Row 7: Dc across, working FP dcs on middle 3 sts. Ch 3, turn.

Row 8: Dc across, working BP dcs on middle 3 sts. Ch 3, turn.

Left shoulder:

Row 9: Dc in 1st 3 sts, fasten yarn.

Right shoulder:

Right side facing, attach yarn to 4th st from last, ch 3, dc in next 3 sts. Fasten off.

Ribbing:

Turn sweater front upside down, right side facing. Attach yarn at right edge.

Row 1: Ch 3, dc in each ch across. Ch 3, turn.

Row 2: Dc across, alternating FP, BP to form ribbing.

Row 3: Rep row 2. Fasten off.

Sweater Back: Ch 29.

First 4 rows: Dc across as for front, omitting FPs and BPs.

Right back:

Row 5: Sl st in 1st 6 sts, ch 3, dc in next 7 sts. Ch 3, turn.

Row 6: Dc across. Ch 3, turn.

Row 7 – 8: Rep row 6.

Row 9: Dc in 1st 3 sts. Fasten yarn.

Left back:

Right side facing, attach yarn in 14th st from end of row.

Row 1: Ch 3, dc in next 8 sts. Ch 3, turn.

Row 2: Dc across. Ch 3, turn.

Row 3 – 4: Rep row 2, ending row 4 with ch 1, turn.

Row 5: Sl st in 1st 3 sts, ch 3, dc across. Fasten yarn.

Sleeves: Ch 20.

Row 1: Dc in 4th ch from hook and in each ch across. Ch 3, turn.

Row 2 - 4: Dc across. Ch 3, turn.

Row 5: 2 dc in 1st st, dc in next 14 sts, 2 dc in next st, dc in last st. Ch 3, turn.

Row 6: 2 dc in 1st st, dc in next 16 sts, 2 dc in next st, dc in last st. Ch 1, turn.

Row 7: Sl st in 1st 3 sts, ch 3, dc in next 15 sts. Ch 3, turn.

Row 8: Dec over 1st 2 sts, dc across to last 3 sts, make dec over 2 sts, dc in last st. Ch 3, turn.

Row 9 – 10: Rep row 8. Fasten yarn.

Cuffs: Work 2 rows of rib stitch as for body of sweater.

Finishing: With right sides together, sew shoulder seams. Sew in sleeves; fold right sides together and sew underarm and side seams. Turn right side out.

Neck trim: Attach yarn at left back neck. Ch 3, dc in next 3 sts, 2 dc in each of next 2 sts, dc in next 5 sts, 2 dc in each of next 2 sts, dc in next 2 sts, work dc, ch2, 2 hdc in next st (buttonhole); work 8 hdc along right back opening, sl st in base of ch-3 at beginning of left back, ch 2, work 12 hdc along left back opening. Fasten yarn.

Weave in ends. Sew button on left back.
