

Spa Cloth



The double crochet rows are smooth, the mesh stitch rows are scrubby... All my recipients have loved these!

Materials:

100% cotton yarn, worsted weight, or acrylic
Crochet hook size K
Yarn needle

Gauge:

3 dcs and 2 spaces = one and one-half inches
2 rows = one and one-half inches

Abbreviations:

Ch = chain
St = stitch
Dc = double crochet
Sp = space

Cloth measures 11 x 11 inches square.

Instructions:

Ch 30.

Row 1: Dc in sixth ch from hook, * ch 1, skip 1 ch, dc in next ch. Repeat from * to end of ch, ch 3, turn.

Row 2: Dc in each dc and each ch-1 sp across; ch 3, turn.

Row 3: Repeat Row 2, but end with ch 4, turn.

Row 4: Dc in next dc, * ch 1, dc in next dc. Repeat from * to end of row; ch 3, turn.

Repeat rows 2 – 4 three times.

Begin Edging:

Rnd 1: Work (dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in same st; continuing along side of dishcloth, * ch 1, dc in end of row. Repeat from * to next corner, work (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in corner st. Continue working around dishcloth in this manner; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3. Do not turn.

Rnd 2: Ch 3, dc in next dc, work (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next ch-2 sp, * dc in next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc. Repeat from * to next corner, work (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next ch-2 sp. Continue working in this manner around dishcloth, ending with sl st in top of beg ch-3. Fasten yarn. Weave in ends securely.

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
